

## SPANISH TYPING CODES

Useful Spanish Typing codes:

Go to "Course Documents" to see some useful Spanish typing codes. Spanish uses accent marks, upside down question marks and exclamation points. Example:

¿Qué tal?

IMPORTANT: You merely hold the alternate button while punching in the numeric code using the keypad to the right (not numbers above!)

Á alt: 0193

á alt: 0225

É alt: 0201

é alt: 0233

Í alt: 0205

í alt: 0237

Ñ alt: 0209

ñ alt: 0241

Ó alt: 0211

ó alt: 0243

Ú alt: 0218

ú alt: 0250

Ü alt: 0220

ü alt: 0252

¿ alt: 0191 (Upside down question mark)

¡ alt: 0161 (Upside down exclamation point)

Another way to type the Spanish accent marks, upside down question marks, etc, is the following:

Go to INSERT

Go to SYMBOLS

Go to MULTINATIONAL
