# Day 3 – (continued)

## Fort Clinch State Park

- **Visitor Center:** open 9:00 – 4:30. Snacks, refreshments, ice, firewood, bait, tackle, educational books, ice cream, coffee, camping supplies & more.
- **Camping:** \$26 per night, plus tax, plus a non-refundable \$6.70 reservation fee. Includes water and electricity at Amelia River and Atlantic Beach campgrounds.
- **Laundry:** Washers, dryers & vending machines are located at each campground restroom.
- **Bike Trails:** 3.3 miles of paved road for those wishing to ride a touring bicycle through the oak shaded canopy drive which terminates at the Visitor Center for historic Fort Clinch. A 6-mile off-road multi-use trail is located adjacent to the park drive and provides a more adventurous ride through the maritime forest as dune elevation changes provide rolling hills and turns.
- **Fort:** Open 9-5. \$2.50 per person.
- **Fort Clinch Museum:** Adjacent to the Visitor's Center. Free with park admission. Open 9 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. The museum displays many of the artifacts associated with Fort Clinch and supplements the unique Living History experience given the visitors by the soldiers in the fort. A **10-minute introductory video** details the history of Fort Clinch while giving visitors a primer to the experience they will encounter inside the Fort itself.



## Day 4 - Tues, May 12

- Fort Clinch State Park Campground (Fernandina Beach, FL) to Anastasia State Park Campground (St. Augustine, FL)
- 69.6 miles

We will cycle along beautiful Florida beaches for the next 5 days!

- Amelia Island Lighthouse (or see it on Day 3) – oldest lighthouse in FL, 67' tall
- Oceanfront parks: Peters Point Beachfront Park, Amelia Island State Park, Big Talbot Island State Park, Little Talbot Island State Park and Huguenot Memorial Park
- St. Johns River Ferry - Ft. George to Mayport, 0.9 mile crossing, departs every half hour (6:15, 6:45, 7:15, 7:45, etc.), \$1.00 fee
- St. Johns River Lighthouse – We will see it when we exit the ferry, but can't visit it. The lighthouse is an 80 ft tall, red-washed conical brick tower with a white lantern. The tower is located on the Mayport Naval Station and is **not open to the public**. **A good view of this lighthouse can be seen from the road east from the Mayport ferry.**
- Beach towns: Cycle through many beach towns, including Atlantic Beach, Neptune Beach, Jacksonville Beach, Ponte Vedra Beach, Vilano Beach, and more

## Day 4 – (continued)

**Anastasia State Park** is a 1,600-acre state park in Florida, United States. Its location is on a peninsula on Anastasia Island across Matanzas Bay from downtown St. Augustine along the Atlantic coastal plain. This park has a variety of wildlife, birds and plants in a setting of beaches, tidal salt marsh, and marine and upland hammock.

### Campground

- Anastasia's full-facility campground features 139 sites with electric and water hookups for RVs and tents.
- Hot water showers and laundry facilities are available.
- The campground is a short stroll from the beach.

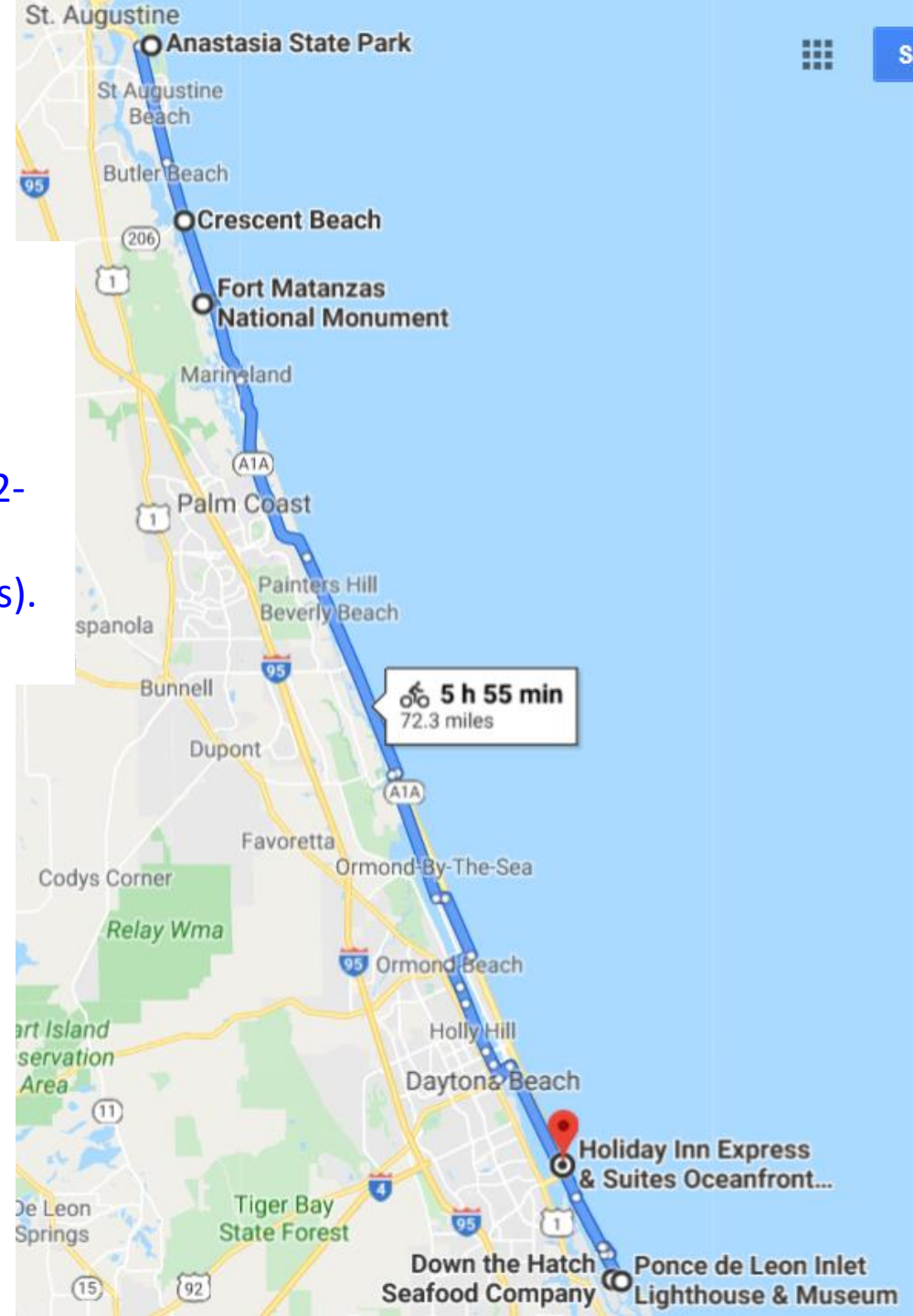
- Cycle 58.5 miles to *Holiday Inn Express & Suites*. Optional stop at *Fort Matanzas National Monument*.

### Ponce de Leon Lighthouse & Museum

Located 6.6 miles south of the hotel at the end of a peninsula at the Ponce de Leon Inlet. The 175' lighthouse was constructed in 1887 and is a National Historic Landmark.

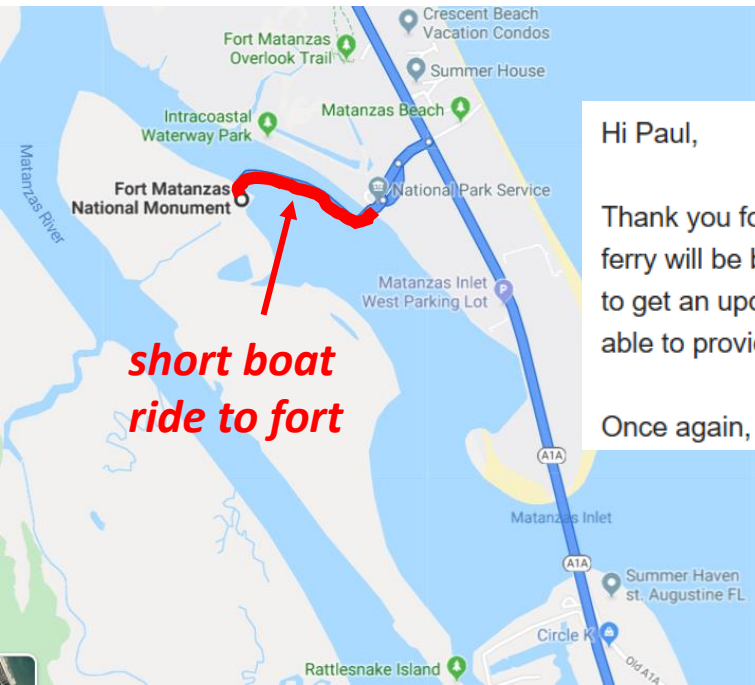

- Fort Matanzas National Monument (optional) – Cycle 0.25 miles off A1A (just south of Daytona Beach) to the NPS Visitor Center and take a **short boat ride (free passenger ferry)** across the Matanzas River to this Spanish fort built in 1740-42.

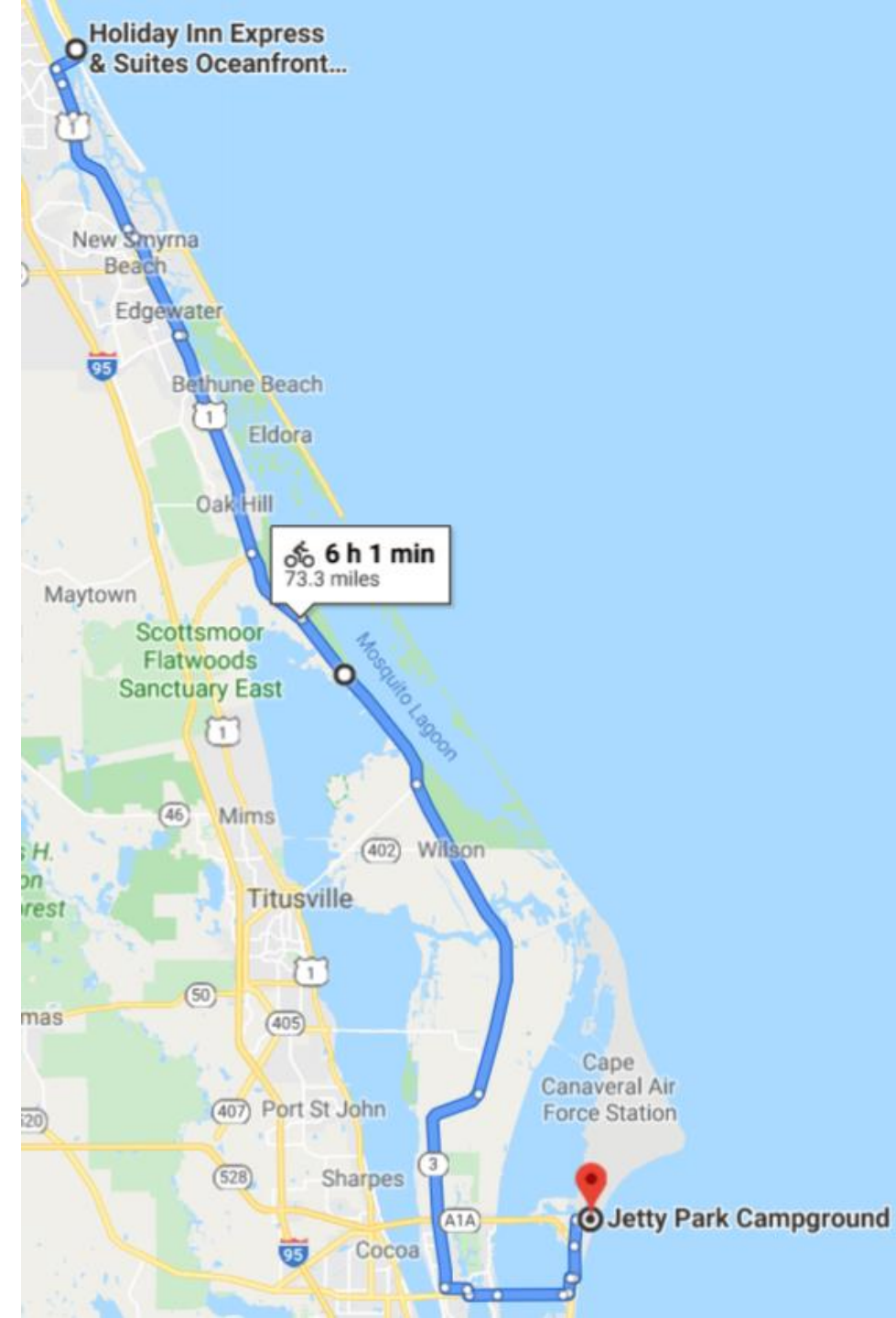
- More beautiful beaches!

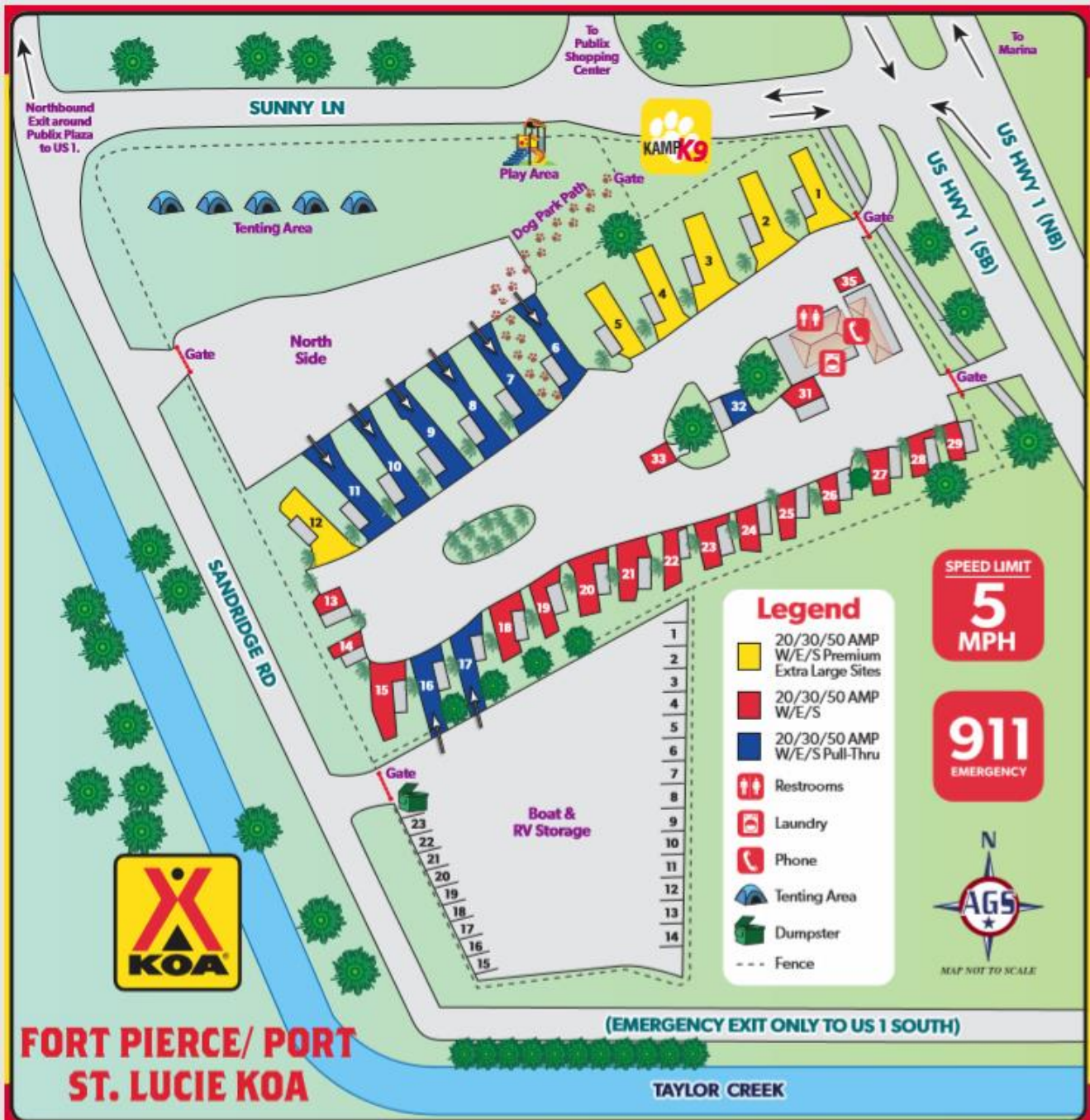

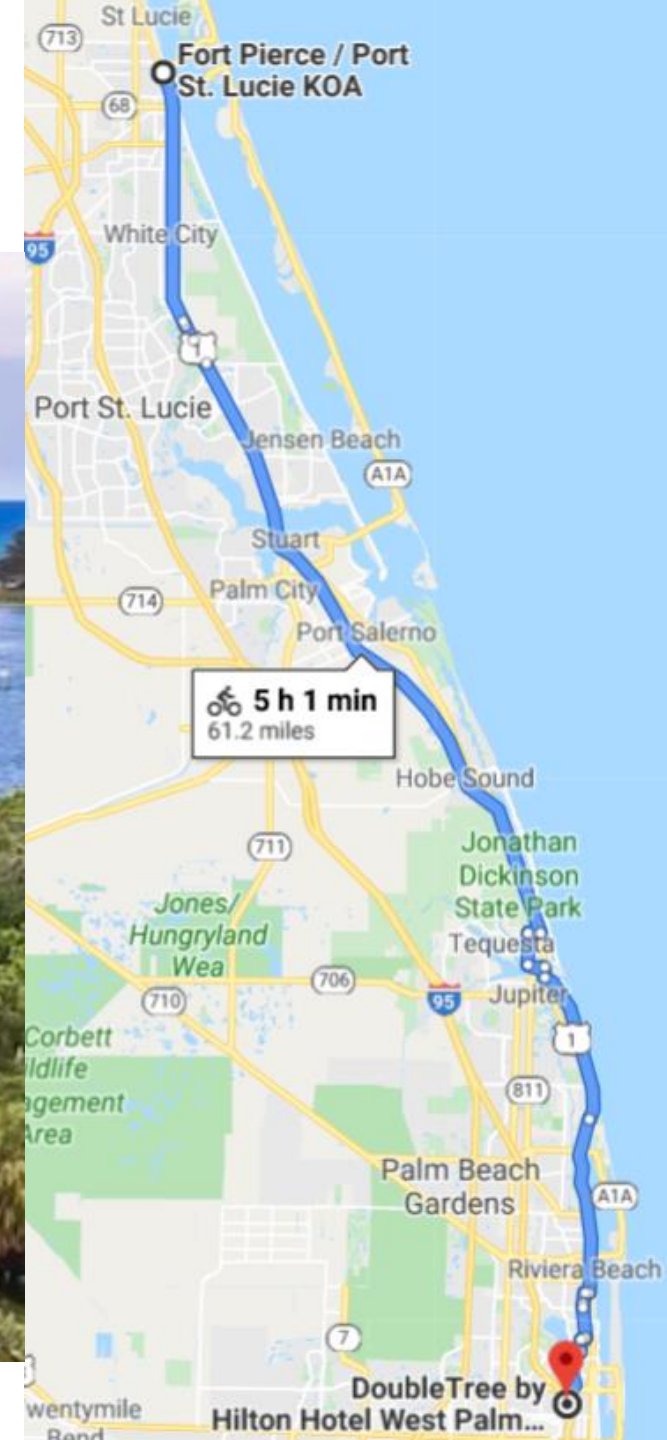

**Jupiter Inlet Lighthouse** - an active lighthouse that is operated by The Loxahatchee River Historical Society. It is 108 feet tall, and is built on a 48 foot Indian mound. The red-washed brick conical tower has 105 steps leading to the black lantern. It was constructed between 1854 and 1860, and is thought to have the oldest first-order Fresnel lens throughout Florida. In addition to being open to the public, there are also sunset tours that require reservations. It was restored in 2000, and also has a museum and gift shop.

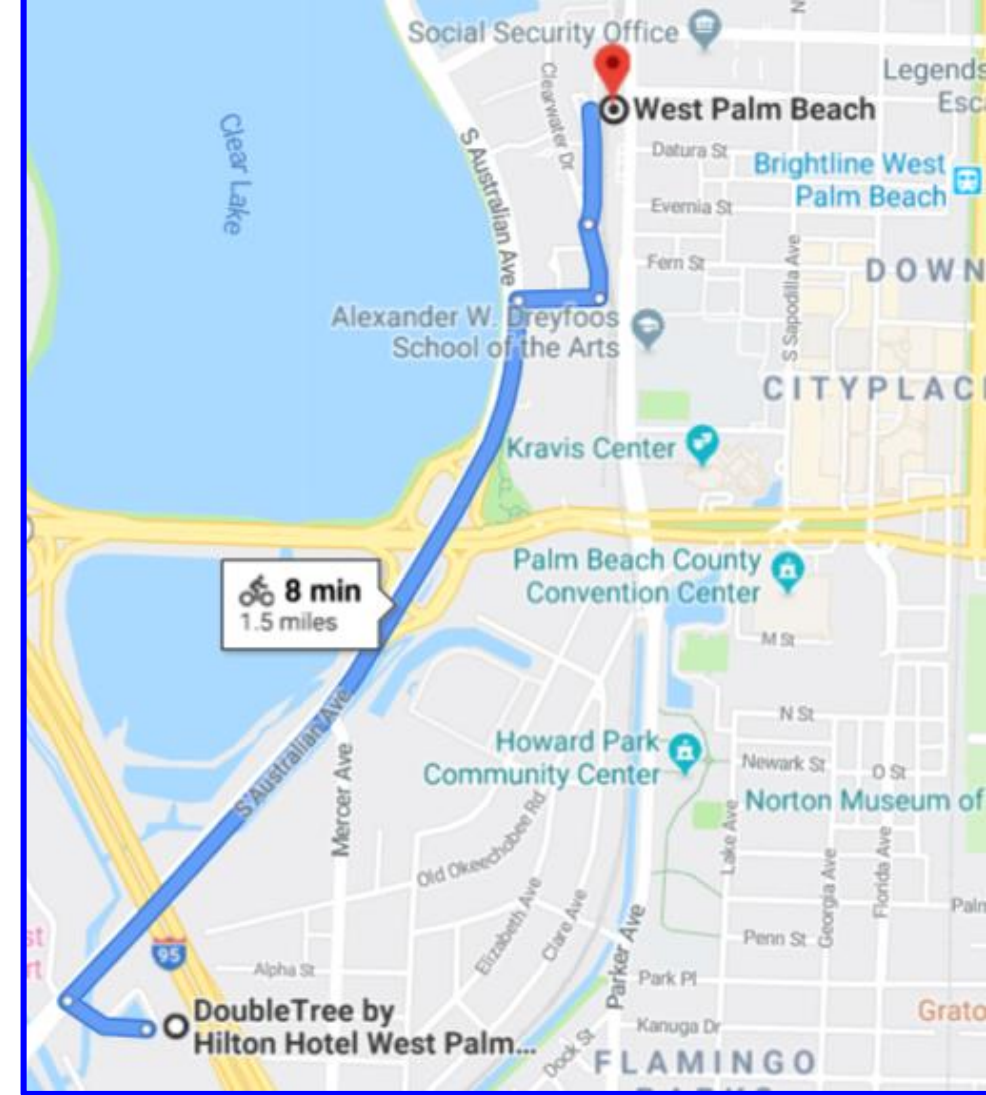

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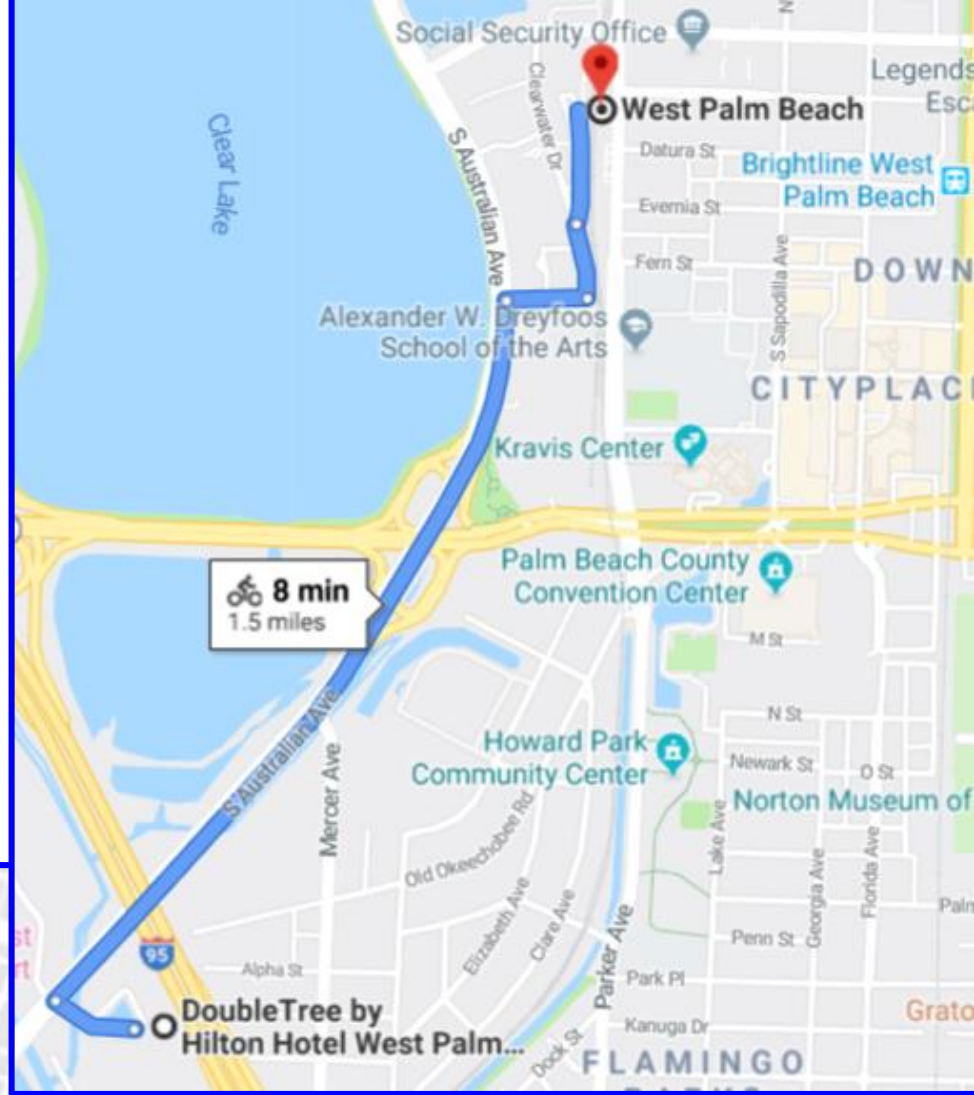

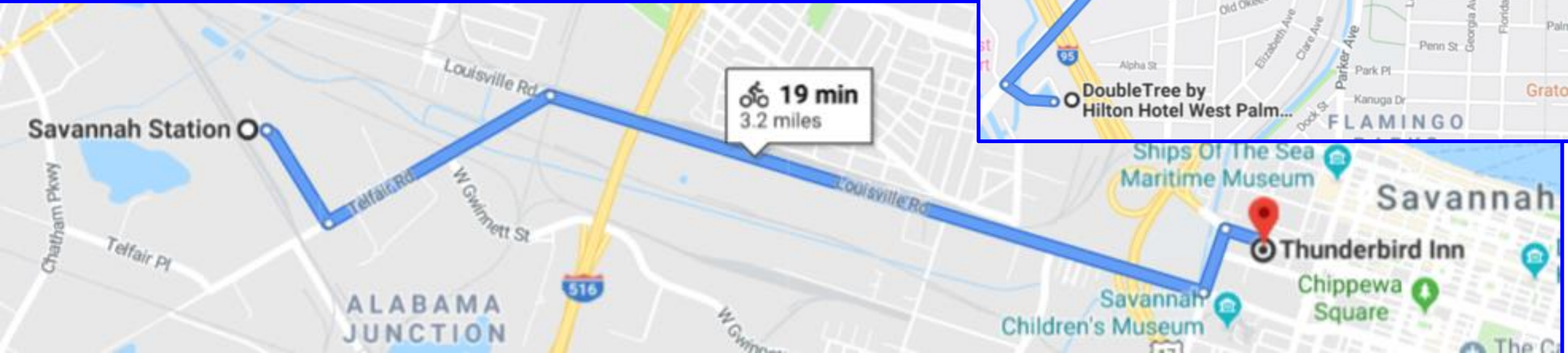
